## HTML Final Assignment

Your final assignment for the web page unit will require you to develop a web site for a particular theme. Read the requirements below and then create a design sketch of your web site. Use your creative talents but be sure to create a web page that appeals to someone interested in your theme.

### 1. Requirements:

- a minimum of three pages, one main page + 2 others
- a suitable theme to which the web site applies

- use of one or more suitable images to match your theme

- use of text styles, colours and sizes to present your material

Quantity
