

## STYLE

Although you have set the basic colours in the document right after the <BODY> tag, it is possible to change colours, size and style of any amount of text throughout the document. You must have an opening tag and a closing tag so make sure you have.

### CHANGING THE FONT SIZE USING HEADER <H\_> AND </H\_>

```
<H1> This is the biggest font </H1>
  <H2> This is the next biggest</H2>
      .....
      .....
  <H6> This is the smallest</H6>
```

There is another method for changing the font size:

```
<FONT SIZE="5">
  The font ranges from size 1-9
</FONT>
```

### CHANGING FONT COLOR

```
<FONT COLOR="RED">
  This is red font
</FONT>
```

### CHANGING THE FONT STYLE

```
<FONT FACE="Comic Sans MS">
  This is Comic Sans font!
</FONT>
```

**IMPORTANT:** You can do it all in one line and then only use one </FONT> tag to close it.

Example:

```
<FONT SIZE="6" COLOR="BLUE" FACE="COMIC SANS SERIF">
  Here we changed everything and only need one closing
  tag after the text.
</FONT>
```
